## 2. REC Design Issues

The group walked through the list of REC design issues, noting the current position on each item which has been captured in the log, alongside any points raised by group members.

Specific points noted were:

- The two highest priority issues discussed at the last meeting continue to be progressed, with the EES impact assessment due to commence later in the year and the workshop to discuss changes to REC owned data items scheduled for 30 September 2022.
- A number of issues have already been discussed by the CCIAG and the Programme were picking
  up specific points to be reflected in design artefacts.
- The changes required to the S Number would impact supplier billing systems and therefore
  required wider consultation with parties. It was agreed that RECCo should consider how to engage
  with parties e.g. whether a REC CP should be raised in order to gather views. ACTION MSAG02 –
  01.
- Potential change to the Erroneous Switch and Disputed / Missing Switch Meter Read processes
  would impact supplier systems and processes. Therefore the issues associated with these
  processes should also be subject to wider REC stakeholder consultation.
- Some issues relate to design artefacts, with comments fed back through the tranche 4 review.
   These items will be updated once responses are received. This may result in some itsms being closed.
- It was suggested that geolocation could be provided as part of a request for a new MPAN. It was
  agreed that this was not an MHHS consequential change, and should instead be fed back into the
  wider discussion on address data quality. ACTION MSAG02 02/
